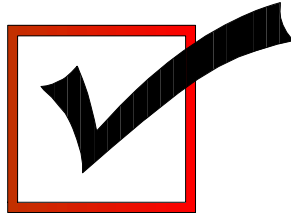

ACTION REQUIRED

Resolutions to Provincial Annual Meeting

Article IX of the ETFO Provincial constitution states that....

9.6 Resolutions to the Annual Meeting may be received from:

(a.) a Local which has passed the motion at a general meeting

9.7 Resolutions must be received in the provincial office by March 1st

Resolutions are motions that create ETFO policy on a wide variety of topics, such as social issues, curriculum, politics, budgetary expenditures, and changes to administrative procedures. Much of the Provincial AGM each summer is dedicated to discussing the many resolutions submitted by ETFO Locals; last year nearly 180 were up for consideration. Any ETFO member may submit a resolution to AGM, provided that it has first been passed at a Local General Meeting. Anyone wishing to submit a resolution, including the rationale for its consideration, may use the form provided. Send it via courier to: **“Todd Rimmington -Resolutions Committee Chair” c/o the Local office by January 22nd, 2009.** Once all submissions are received, the Committee will publish them two weeks prior to the Wed. Feb. 10th General Meeting where they will be presented & debated.
